## **2015/2016 Race Season Review**

The September endurance meeting had good fields again with some interesting machinery on display and Sunday had the first Clubmans round for the season. What started well didn't carry on to the November meeting because we had to cancel it through lack of entries for the first time in many years. The race committee may look at a different format for this meeting because it hasn't been very well patronised for the last couple of years. December was a good meeting with several registers attending.

The January meeting was the best we have had for a long time with quality fields in all classes and a large number of spectators. A big thank you goes to Ray White Real Estate and the Invercargill City Council for their assistance in putting on this meeting. Even though we had a major incident with a super truck taking out a section of Armco down the main straight the weekend went off well. The race committee would have to thank all those involved in doing a great repair job on the Armco barrier that enabled the race meeting to keep going, especially Purdue Bros with their cranes and highly skilled operators. The outcome may have been completely different without them.

The Speedfest in February was another successful meeting with good fields and spectators and thanks must go to Rick & Fiona Michels at Evolution Motorsport for their continued support.

The last meeting for the season was the March Race Meeting which included NZ6, Pre 65, Sports & Racing, and Clubmans along with the A1 Auto Services 1hr Race. This meeting was of course marred by the incident involving Inky Tulloch at the loop and we continue to wish him all the best during his recovery. A special thank you to the marshalls involved who did a fantastic job.

The first 'Last Man Standing' competition which started in September 2014 is down to 5 competitors with a prize pool of \$355. The second one which started in September 2015 has 11 competitors with a prize pool of \$210. Another one will start at the beginning of next season. These will continue on and the prize pool will keep increasing until there is only one person left in each competition and they take the prize.

A big thank you goes to all our volunteers for their efforts throughout the season. It's been said time and time again, but the truth is that without all of you we wouldn't be able to run the successful race meetings that we do. We are always looking for more helpers at race meetings so if you have spare time on race days we would appreciate your help especially with flag marshalling and crash crews.
